1 Semester hours per term may vary. Tuition, fees, and estimated student loan maximums may be reduced should semester hours per term decrease and increased if semester hours increase. If eligible, you may be able to borrow an additional loan, up to a maximum of \$6,833 per term when enrolled in three terms per year and up to a maximum of \$5,125 when enrolled in four terms per year.

2 Tuition and student fees listed are effective Summer 2016 through Spring 2017 during which core courses are \$774 per credit hour. Student fees are currently \$130 per term. The estimated student loan amount needed may increase slightly to cover loan origination fees of 1.068% for Federal Direct Stafford loan (current interest rate is 5.84%) and 4.272% for Federal Direct Graduate PLUS (current interest rate is 6.84%) loans.
