Students must be enrolled at least half-time to be eligible to borrow a Federal student loan. **The estimated student loan amount needed may increase slightly to cover loan origination fees** of 1.059% for Federal Direct Stafford loan (current interest rate is 6.08%) and 4.236% for Federal Direct Graduate PLUS (current interest rate is 7.08%) loans.
