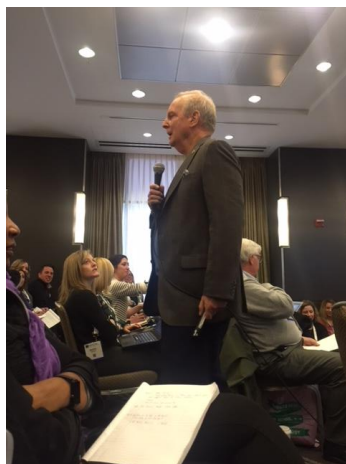


## HAPPY SPRING!

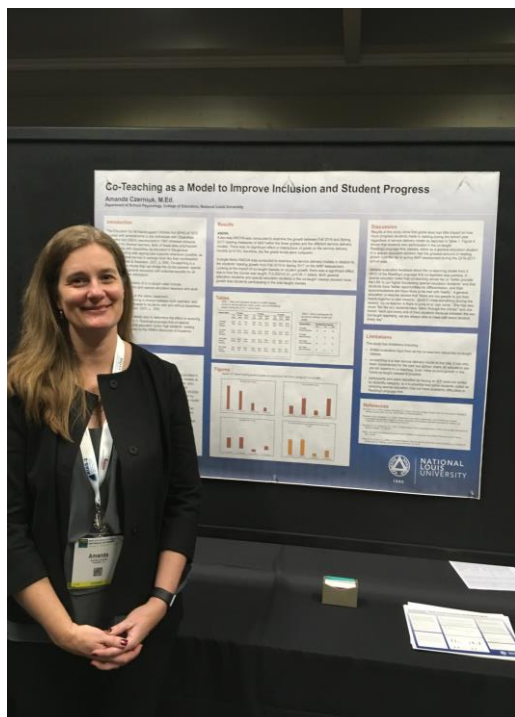

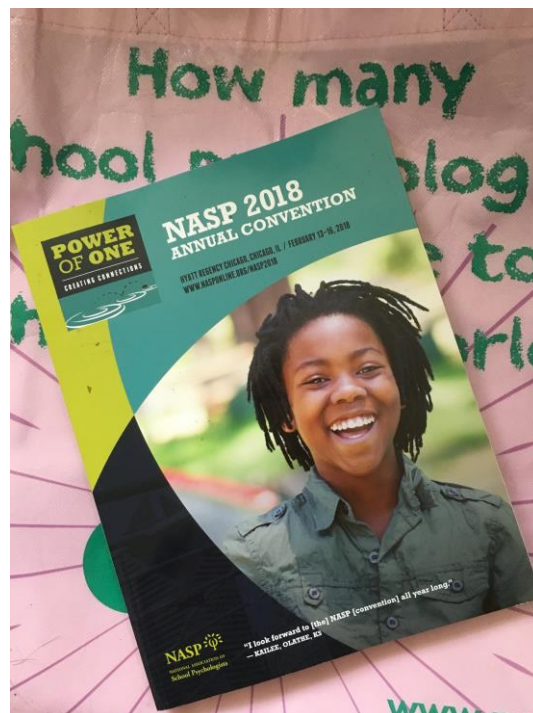
