Summer Reading Improvement Program National Louis University

North Shore Campus

The Graduate Reading Program at National Louis University is offering a Summer Reading Improvement Program at the North Shore campus in Skokie. This program is designed to help students who are experiencing reading and/or writing difficulties. The tutors are certified teachers who are earning their graduate degrees as Reading Specialists. Highly qualified university faculty and staff will supervise the tutors. Students receive one-to-one tutoring in reading and writing one hour per day, four mornings per week, for five weeks.

Note: Children must attend each day for all five weeks.
