The Graduate Reading Program at National Louis University is offering a Summer Reading Improvement Program at the Wheeling campus. This program is designed to help students who are experiencing reading and/or writing difficulties. The tutors are certified teachers who are earning their graduate degrees as Reading Specialists. Highly qualified university faculty and staff will supervise the tutors. Students receive one-to-one tutoring in reading and writing one hour per day, four mornings per week, for five weeks. ***Please note, in case of campus closure resulting from Covid 19, the program will be held remotely.***
